

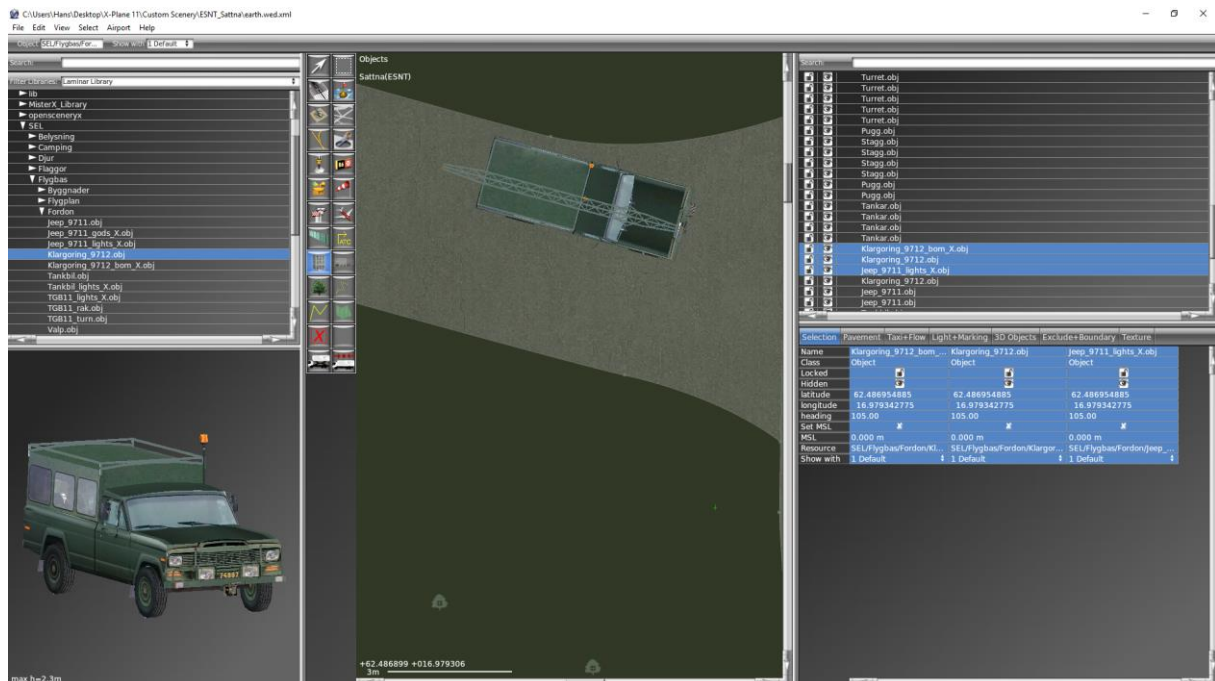
How to use some of the objects in SE-lib

The SE-lib has some extra features in order to minimize the size of the library and at the same time add extra flexibility to the designer.

Some object is design as a “mother” object. You can add one or more accessories to this basic model to give variations. For example you can have a truck with or without lights or a pickup with or without loads.

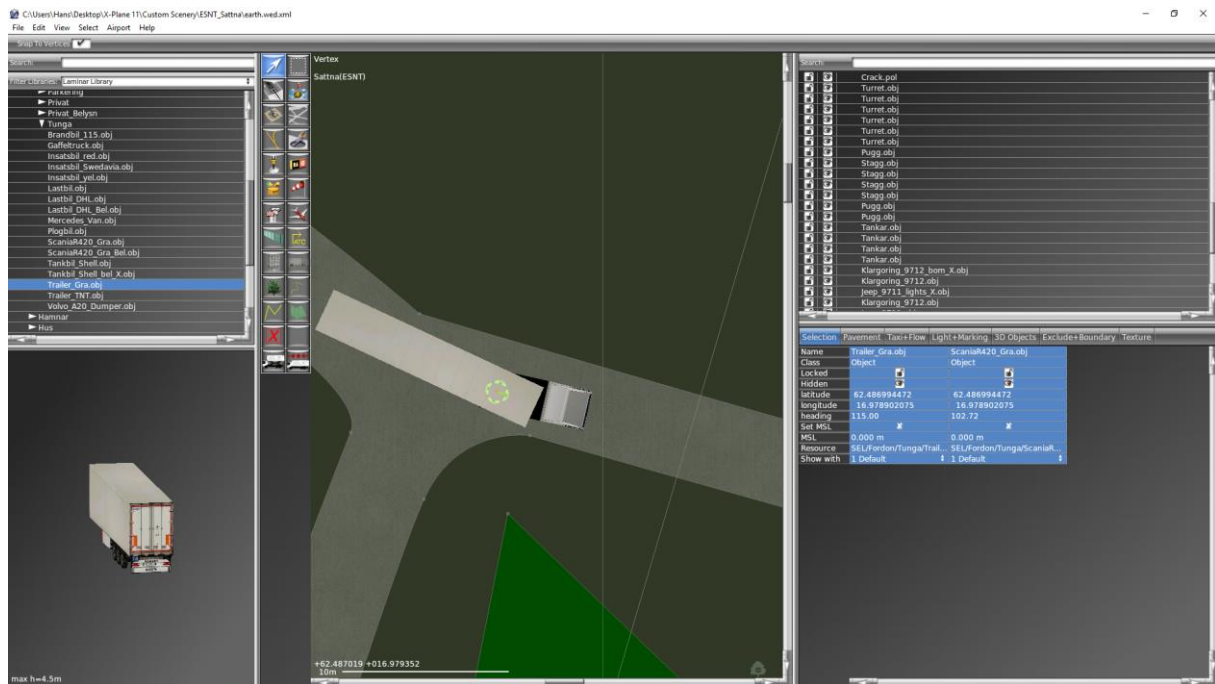
The accessories have normally an “X” in the end of name, but could also just have “bel” for lights, and some early doesn’t have any symbols in the naming at all.

The crucial thing is that you have all positions exactly the same in WED. If you want to move them later on in the design it’s recommended to use the group tool instead of select tool.



Here a military van with two additions. To get them right, after selecting them into WED, just copy lat/lon/head from mother object to the additions. In this case a ladder and lights.

Cargo trucks with optional trailer



In this case it's possible to let the trailer have any heading, leaving lat/lon in the same position.
